1. I MUST TRUST GOD AS MY _____ AND _____.

The source of my income is God, not my job.

2. I MUST KEEP GOOD _____.

- If I want God's blessing, I must learn to use a budget.

*Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds; for riches do not endure forever, and a crown is not secure for all generations. **Proverbs 27:23-24 NIV***

5. I MUST SET UP A REPAYMENT _____ TO GET MYSELF OUT OF DEBT.

Do not withhold repayment of your debts. Proverbs 3:27 (Paraphrase).

6. I MUST _____ MY SPENDING.

- A budget allows you to control your money, instead of letting money control you.

7. I MUST _____ WHAT I HAVE.
